CASE STUDY

Srey Ka - 9 years old

Student from Cambodia. Lives with her parents and her two siblings.

Due to a traumatic injury, Srey Ka developed a cataract in her left eye, causing her blurry vision and tearing. She had difficulty seeing things clearly, recognizing faces, and going anywhere outside. When Srey Ka learned about Children's Surgical Centre, she traveled for two hours with her mother seeking treatment. On June 15, doctors performed a phacoemulsification cataract surgery and an intraocular lens implant in her left eye. After recovery, she will be able to see clearly. Srey Ka said, I hope I can play sports with my friends again and see the teacher in school.

"Things are so hard in Cambodia now, but Srey Ka can see better and will grow up to be successful and beautiful." - Srey Ka's Mother.
